6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; requiring school district
8 boards of education and charter school governing
9 bodies to request a national criminal history record
10 check for volunteers beginning in certain school
11 year; defining term; directing the Oklahoma State
12 Bureau of Investigation to obtain fingerprints and
13 require payment of certain fee; providing for deposit
14 of fee into certain fund; allowing reimbursement of
15 certain search cost; requiring school district boards
16 of education and charter school governing bodies to
17 publish certain notice on certain websites; providing
18 certain exceptions; providing for codification;
19 providing an effective date; and declaring an
20 emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-142.2 of Title 70, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

25 A. Except as otherwise provided in subsection D of this
26 section, beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, a school district
27 board of education and the governing body of a charter school shall
28 request that the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI)
29 provide a national criminal history record check for a volunteer

1 prior to the individual volunteering at a school district or charter
2 school site. For the purposes of this section, "national criminal
3 history record check" shall have the same meaning as provided for in
4 Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes. OSBI shall
5 obtain fingerprints of the volunteer and require that the person pay
6 a search fee not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or the cost of the
7 search, whichever is the lesser amount. The fee shall be deposited
8 into the OSBI Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 150.19a of
9 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 B. A school district board of education or the governing body
11 of a charter school may reimburse volunteers for the cost of the
12 search required by subsection A of this section.

13 C. Each school district board of education and governing body
14 of a charter school shall publish on its website notice of the
15 national criminal history record check required by subsection A of
16 this section and whether the school district or charter school
17 provides reimbursement for the cost of the search, as allowed by
18 subsection B of this section.

19 D. School district or charter school volunteers who meet the
20 criteria provided for in subsection F of Section 5-142 of Title 70
21 of the Oklahoma Statutes may not be required to have a national
22 criminal history record check.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
