15	Section 3-118. No alcoholic beverages intended for <del>off-premise</del>
16	off-premises or on-premises consumption shall be sold at
17	retail for less than <del>a six percent (6%) markup</del> <u>actual unit cost</u> ,
18	unless the sale meets one or more of the following conditions:
19	1. Where seasonable merchandise is sold in bona fide clearance
20	sales, if advertised, marked and sold as such;
21	2. Where merchandise is imperfect or damaged or is being
22	discontinued and is advertised, marked and sold as such;
23	3. Where merchandise is sold upon the final liquidation of any

1	4. Where merchandise is sold for charitable purposes or to
2	relief agencies;
3	5. Where merchandise is sold on contract to departments of the
4	government or governmental institutions;
5	6. Where merchandise is sold by any officer acting under the
6	order or direction of any court; or
7	7. Where merchandise is sold at any bona fide auction sale.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
