21	faith for millions of Oklahomans and Christians worldwide,

freedom of its citizens to express their deeply held beliefs,

including freedom of speech without fear of punishment or
retribution, recognizing the importance of religious liberty as

Constitution; and

WHEREAS, this proclamation serves as an expression of gratitude for the blessings bestowed upon the State of Oklahoma and as a recognition of the enduring influence of Christian faith in the lives of its people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby proclaims "Christ is King," recognizing the spiritual significance of this declaration to many of its citizens and honoring the role of faith in the history and culture of Oklahoma.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature expresses that this resolution is not intended to establish any religion or infringe upon the rights of any individual, but rather to celebrate the voluntary expression of belief that has shaped communities across the state.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor of Oklahoma and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives,
